We thank the Lord for the progress made with our farming ministry this year. From our first group of farmers, earlier this year, we have several that have been able to enlarge their gardens this season because of help with supplies they received last planting season. They are preparing, after harvest, to give a portion of their crops back so that we can use the seed to share with others. We have 32 farmers in our program at the present and we have more candidates waiting when we are ready for them. We cannot help them all at once as we need to oversee their farms and be equipped with supplies to assist each one. We desire to reach as many families as possible, showing them the love of Christ as we encourage them in their farming. Helping them to support themselves and their families also being able to hire people to work in their fields thus creating jobs in their communities. We are grateful for those who have invested in these people and in the future of Haiti.
