Family Update

In November 2024 all flights to Haiti were shut down for at least 30 days. We were not able to travel in December as we had considered. The 'no travel from the US to Haiti' keeps getting extended and the Port au Prince airport continues to be closed due to gang violence. There are other flights in the Caribbean that now travel from Florida to Northern Haiti. We will plan to use this route when we are able to return. While it has been hard being away from our family in Haiti we have a lot to be grateful for. While here for an extended period of time we have been able to work

on some paperwork that needed to be done.

Cenofa has finished his paperwork and is waiting on immigration. This will make it possible for him to continue to travel back and forth to the US. After we get a final response we will pray about when to return to Haiti. Our young children are blessed to be getting to know family and life in the States; meanwhile our children in Haiti are being well cared for by our friends Sadrac and Ruth. We are humbled how God has been providing for us while we are here in the States. We continue to send all of GHRH donations to Haiti for the continued ministry in Montrouis as well as the growing work in Les Cayes. We are thankful to have faithful Christians who are continuing the Lord's work in Haiti while we are away.



Gardening God's Way

In Les Cayes we are assisting farming families to be able to have bigger and better crops, to be better able to feed their families and have enough to sell. So far we have eight acres of land ready to be farmed this will assist nearly 20 families. It will cost \$1,125 per acre. If you feel the call to give please don't hesitate, the time is crucial. US AID, one of the main food providers has pulled out of Haiti and food imports are becoming more difficult. It could eventually be a good thing for Haiti to once again support itself, but it will be hard for awhile. Now is the time for the Haitian people to step up, we can help those farmers to grow more to support their families and their communities. You can be a monthly sponsor or a one time contributor. Any size donation makes a difference in someone's life.

We are now able to send supplies to Haiti using Agape flights. If anyone is interested in sending items or helping pay shipping expenses for supplies we are sending, please contact us or speak with Bonita. We have sent cases of New Testaments to Les Cayes and they have been sharing them with the neighborhood as they come to get water from our well. Many don't have any Bible in their home and are very grateful to receive a Bible of their own. We are so grateful for those God has led to work along with us in Haiti as well as monetary and prayer support to be "God's Hands Reaching Haiti". Thank you and May God Bless You

We would like to introduce you to our field workers. We could not do this work of reaching the Haitian people with the gospel without working together as a body.

We have you all who pray and give as we go and we have fellow Christians working with us in Haiti.

Sadrac and Ruth -Have moved to Les Cayes because of the unrest in Montrouis. They are working with God's Hands Reaching, living with our foster children, caring for them while we are away and keeping up with our mission work there. They have three boys, 8yrs, 6yrs and 4yrs. We have known them for many years and appreciate who they are and how they are raising their family. Sadrac has translated with Cenofa at hospitals and has had schooling for accounting. He is teaching our foster children French as well as helping with the girl's English education including memorizing Scriptures in all three languages. Sadrac also does the accounting work for our farming ministry in Les Cayes. Ruth has done housework and cooking for American missionaries and has cooked at a resort. She does well shopping and cooking nutritious meals for our household and caring for her own children. They at times attend a small church in the neighborhood and at times lead home church for our household. We speak to them often, keeping the lines of communication open so that we can make decisions together and we can know how things are going there.




